BUDAPEST, Hungary, July 23 (AP)—Deputy Hungarian Foreign Minister Karoly Csatorday, chairman of the U.N. Security Council for a month in 1969, died today of injuries suffered when his glider plane crashed during competition Thursday. He was 46.

He entered the Hungarian diplomatic service in 1948 and served in The Hague, Peking, Hanoi and as ambassador in Tokyo. In 1962, he became Hungary's permanent United Nations representative and served there until his recent appointment as deputy foreign minister.
