Dorati:  
*In Gold,*  
*On Screen*

Antal Dorati's recordings of the complete symphonies of Haydn have sold over a million copies. For this landmark, Dorati was given the customary gold-plated disc Thursday by London Records, on whose label Dorati and the Philharmonia Hungarica released the historic series. The series occupies 48 discs, and required 350 miles of tape to complete.

Channel 26 (WETA) will carry a half-hour interview with Dorati Thursday evening at 9 when Mike Cuthbert talks with the National Symphony conductor about various aspects of his career. Dorati says one difference between his Washington and London audiences is a matter of manners. His pet peeve is "the segment of the Washington audience who talk out before the conclusion of the program."
